Hello Parents, Leaders and Campers,

I want to take a minute and walk you through the registration process and other information for Youth Camp 2010. Camp is going to be outstanding this year with our guest speaker Pastor Christian Bowers bringing the word to us daily. South Carolina School of Leadership Worship Team will be leading worship this year, so services this year are going to be so incredible, plan to have any encounter with God. The daily challenges are going to be more involved with the camp theme this year, but just as fun. Like I said, Camp is going to be incredible and I can't wait to see you all there in June!

Here is what you need to know.

LOCATION: Milford Park Camp, Route-100 Zionsville, PA 18092

WHEN: Sunday, June 27th, 2010 – July 1st, 2010

Arrival: Sunday, June 27th, 2010 after 3:00PM

CONCLUSION: Thursday, July 1st, 2010. Closing Service starts at 7:00PM

Departure of students is scheduled for post-service

COST: \$180.00 This covers meals, lodging, and all camp activities. You may want to bring extra money for the incredible snack bar that is open during the day and after the night services or if you want to buy stuff at the camp store.

Things to Bring:

Bible, Sleeping Bag, Fan, Water Bottles, Towels, Pillow and blankets, Modest Bathing Suit (one piece), Clothing for dress and play (including Sneakers and Shoes that can get wet) bring clothing for each day, Medications, Bathroom needs (including soap and shampoo), Games that you want to play during the day (ex. Chess), Any sports equipment (Frisbees, Footballs, Baseballs), Camera

Items brought on trips are the responsibility of the person bringing them. If an item is lost, broken or stolen it is not the responsibility of Family Worship Center, its employees or volunteers to replace them. If you choose to bring personal items, you bring them at your own risk.

Things not to Bring:

Cell Phones, Radios, Portable players of any kind, iPods, Skateboards, Fireworks, Candles, Tobacco, Narcotics, Alcohol, Purple, and ***Weapons of any kind.***

"We will confiscate them."

Registration Process:

1. Return the registration and medical paperwork with your full payment or the \$75.00 non-refundable deposit by **June 13th** to secure your registration. The remaining balance is due at the beginning of camp on June 27th.
2. Please make all checks payable to Family Worship Center and return to Pastor Ken Compton (Youth Pastor) or give them to the church office.
3. Camp Cost includes meals, lodging, and all camp activities. Please bring some extra money for the snack bar or camp store.
4. Campers will be assigned to housing. On the registration form please indicate roommate preferences. We will do our best with rooming requests.

Discounts & Scholarships:

1. **Early-Bird Registration Discount:** To receive a \$10 discount, turn in your registration form and full payment **on or before May 14th**.
2. **Bring a Friend:** Get a \$5.00 discount for every paid registration received from a non-FWC student. They get \$5.00 off too!
3. **Scholarships:** If you need a scholarship, please contact Pastor Ken. Scholarship funds are limited and will be distributed according to need.

Dress Code:

All Campers and staff must dress modestly. Please remember we are there to honor God and to grow in our relationship with Him. We don't want to prevent someone who is seeking the Lord by distracting them with what we are wearing. A one piece bathing suit for girls and long swim trunks for the guys is appropriate.
